Monday January 12, 2015

The regular Monthly Meeting of the West Caln Township Board of Supervisors was held on Monday January 12, 2015 at 7:00 P.M. in the Township Municipal Building. Present were Supervisors Martin, Martz, and Pfitzenmeyer, Police Chief Martinez, Road Forman Touchton, Fire Marshal Peters, Assistant Manager Russell, and Manager/Secretary Dunlap. There were 7 citizens in attendance.

Chairman Pfitzenmeyer opened the meeting and lead in the flag salute. The following business was then conducted.

1. Citizen Comments. None.
2. Treasurer's Report for December 2014.

Mr. Dunlap presented the report. Mr. Martz moved to accept the report as read. Second, Mr. Pfitzenmeyer. Questions, none. Vote was 3-0 in favor of the motion.

3. Supervisor's Minutes, December 8, and 15, 2014.

4. Police Report for December 2014.

Chief Martinez reported that the Department worked 1255.5 hours, traveled 7631 miles, and received 771 complaints. The Police investigated 10 Accidents, and made 27 arrests. In addition, 21 Traffic Warnings were issued, and 256 Business/Vacation Checks were made.

5. Manager's Report.

Mr. Dunlap reported that he is receiving resumes for the position of Solicitor upon Mr. Moskovitz's retirement. He further reported that Mr. Moskovitz is ready to file the lien in connection with the unpaid invoices for the Calnshire Development and he informed the Board that Diane Eckenbach's term was up on the Planning Commission.

Mr. Pfitzenmeyer moved to re-appoint Ms. Eckenbach to another term. Second, Mr. Martz. Questions, none. Vote was 3-0 in favor.

6. Fire and Ambulance.

Wagontown Assistant Chief Patton reported that his company responded to 22 calls in December, of which, 10 were in West Caln, 5 in West Brandywine, 7 in other municipalities. John Sly reported that Westwood Ambulance 1-44 responded to 91 calls during the month. 31, in West Caln, 34 in West Brandywine, and the balance in other municipalities.

11. Old Business.


A. Park Fees. Tabled until the Parks Committee can review.
