There would be a single ingress/egress to Airport Road with a secondary access for emergency vehicles only. This proposed development would be a gated community with amenities for the homeowners. Road would be private so no maintenance would be required from the township. Public water will be utilized and they are discussing public sewer connection with PA American Water. A full traffic study and fiscal study will be completed as part of the land development process.
