- a. Jill Townsend, 111 Captiva Way Asked about the status of the horse ordinance. Supervisor Martz advised her that there has been no further movement. Question regarding fees if a variance would need to be filed. Fees would be a total of \$1,750 \$1,500 escrow and \$250 administrative fee. Would any properties be grandfathered. Grandfathering is only considered if the property had a legal use before the ordinance was in place. If the property was not compliant then it would not be grandfathered. Ordinance was changed based on recommendations from Penn State Agricultural Department and Chester County Planning Commission.
- b. Omar Esh, 201 Leary Rd Asked if there was anything that could be done about the water runoff along Leary Road near the schoolhouse. It was noted that a spring has opened up along Leary Road causing more water to flow along the road. The township will take a look at it to see what if anything can be done.
- c. Pat McVey 266 Green Valley Road Excess ice has been forming along Airport Road near the bridge. Thank you to the road department for continuing to keep it clear.
