 - a) A number of on-site issues mentioned at Public Workshop.
 - b) Phone with Joe Borgioni at Hydraterra, engineers for the Act 537 Sewage Facility Plan.
 - i) Another consultant prepared a 537 Plan that was rejected by DEP in January of 2016 or 2017 due to a lack of information on existing system failures in the sewer management plan. The plan only used a Chester County database of septic tank pumping, but nothing about failures or other issues. He said this database can only be accessed by the township manager.
 - ii) They are currently completing a survey of the areas around the Kings Highway Elementary School project which is getting public sewer. This is to determine if there is a need to extend service into adjacent areas. This will be completed in the next month or so.
 - iii) They are also working on an inventory of existing issues/failures throughout the township, but this will not be completed for 2 years.
